
## G. A. Theme: Following Jesus Christ through the Pandemic and Beyond (Zephaniah 3:17; Mark 4:40)



Premise: Implications of following Jesus for the Church and the Africa God wants through and during the pandemic must be firmly built and rooted in Christ. The critical strategy we have as a community of God's people in creating a just and righteous society that is firmly built and rooted in Christ is discipleship. When people are taught all that Christ did and said, and they pattern their life accordingly, they will exhibit and practice Christlike qualities that will transform the social, economic, political, and environmental fabric of our societies (Main speaker). The mission and role of the Church is central to effectively containing the virus owing to its unique position to influence and transform communities and authorities in various jurisdictions coupled with existing local community trust and theological foundation to advocate for the most vulnerable and often forgotten members of a given community. It is the unique opportunity God has given to the church to make disciples in our collective hour of need and dependence on Him.

The community of God must use its structures and resources during these pandemic times to build such leaders through family discipleship in which the primary socialization of the individual to become a just and righteous person happens (Topic 2), through corporate or individual Christian responsibility as offered by the body of Christ in nurturing such individuals for works of righteousness (Topic 3) and through the training institutions and programs organized and sanctioned by the Church to formally train such individuals to become multipliers of themselves as required by 2 Timothy 2:2 (Topic 4) and to "go and make disciples of all nations" (ethne), "teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you."
