Our event on "Faith and Science: Towards COP26" in Rome on 3-4 October is almost upon us.

In the morning of 4 October, at the Vatican, we will have simultaneous translation of English, Arabic, Portuguese and Italian. Additionally, in the afternoon, at Palazzo Bartolomeo, we will have simultaneous translation of English, Arabic, Portuguese, Cantonese, Japanese and Mandarin (see Annex).

All participants should arrive at the Vatican through the *Ingresso del Perugino (Vicolo del Perugino)*. As you know, we will need the licence plate of the car, name of the driver and driver vaccination confirmation.
